

2012 National Special Needs Team Safety Roadeo Driving Course Contestant Procedures

Driving course events for the 15th Special Needs Roadeo will take place in an international bus that is 40 ft long which is the same as a 65 passenger conventional bus. The Special Needs Roadeo driving course is similar to the "regular" bus roadeo, but with fewer events. As in the real world, during the Special Needs driving course, driver and attendant will also have to contend with the distractions of managing "students" with emotional disabilities. The students will be picked up at the start of the course and dropped off at the end. *Note: attendant MAY assist driver (observing, alerting, etc.) during any driving course event.*

Special Needs Driving Course Events:

- **Serpentine:** same as regular bus roadeo, but barrels re-set for appropriate size bus.
- **Railroad Crossing:** same as regular bus roadeo.
- **Alley Dock:** same as regular bus roadeo.
